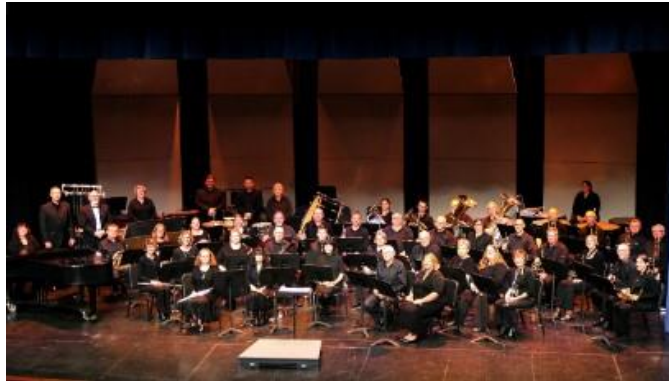

EVENTS

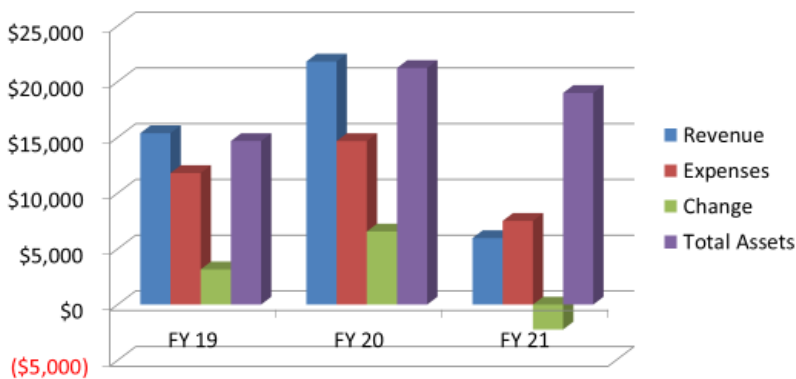
- Due to COVID restrictions, we were not able to present any events in person for this fiscal year.
